Dr. Watson's expertise resides in all aspects of quality arts and sciences emphasizing applied statistics, benchmarking, reliability, production operations, strategic management, and business systems engineering.

Greg's expertise is evident by his service as a Past-President and Fellow of the American Society for Quality where he has been awarded its highest recognition as an Honorary Member.
